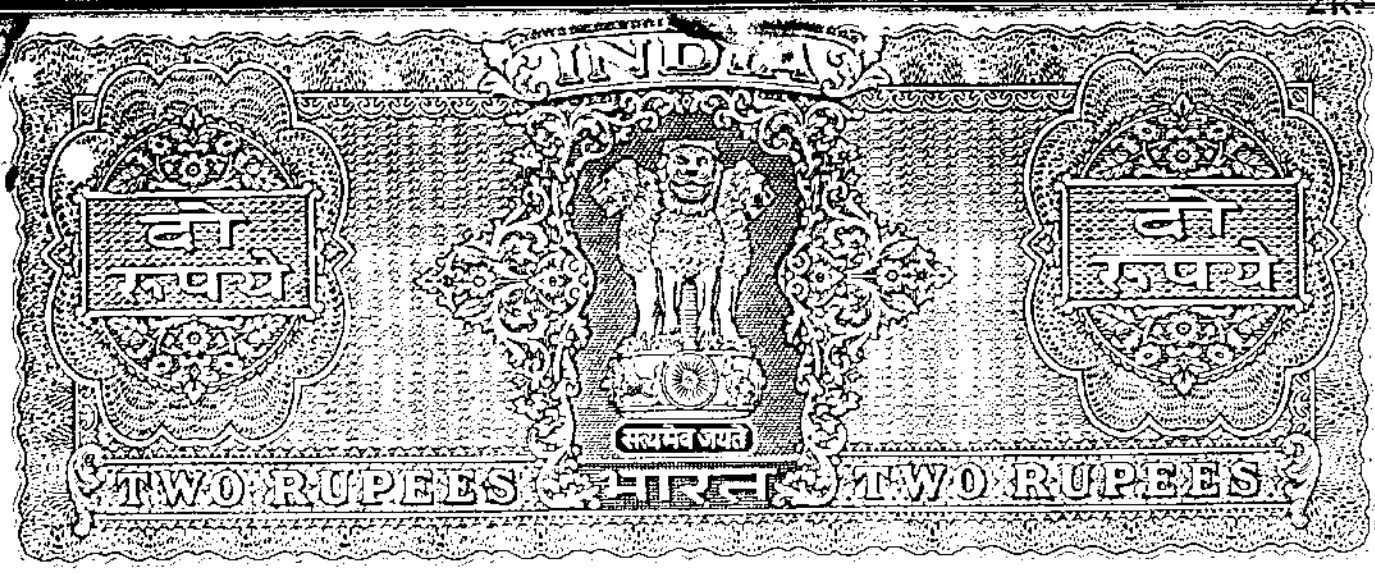

Objects

The objects for which the Society is established are the following:-

- a) To promote rural & tribal folk-art & culture with documentation, dissemination, exhibit & media in protecting & preserving the heritage of Orissa beyond state & national territories
- b) To prepare artists in the different branches of performing art like dance, song, music, duly accredited & affiliated under different institutes & universities with residential & non-residential facilities & institutional infrastructure
- c) To award certificate to the students of the district of Navagarh who are engaged in performing art
- d) To organize & conduct various cultural & national programmes, seminars, workshops, conferences, camps & students level cultural activities & national integration.
- e) To provide students enrolled in courses and curriculums & with extra-curricular activities like Yoga, Sports, NSS, etc
- f) To undertake research & studies in the philosophy & aesthetic value of arts
- g) To undertake studies in the advancement of performing art with thrust on talent search in arts & creating endowment & scholarships for the same
- h) To organise open opera, drama, street play, stage management, documentary films, video recording, inter village-cultural exchanges in the recreation & entertainment of people
- i) To create awareness among people through theatrical action for communicating messages to the masses & for mobilization of development



i) To prepare youth volunteers for voluntarism and voluntary action for services to people during epidemics, natural and man-made disasters

k) To provide rehabilitation to the poor through various art & craft, applied arts, craft centres etc

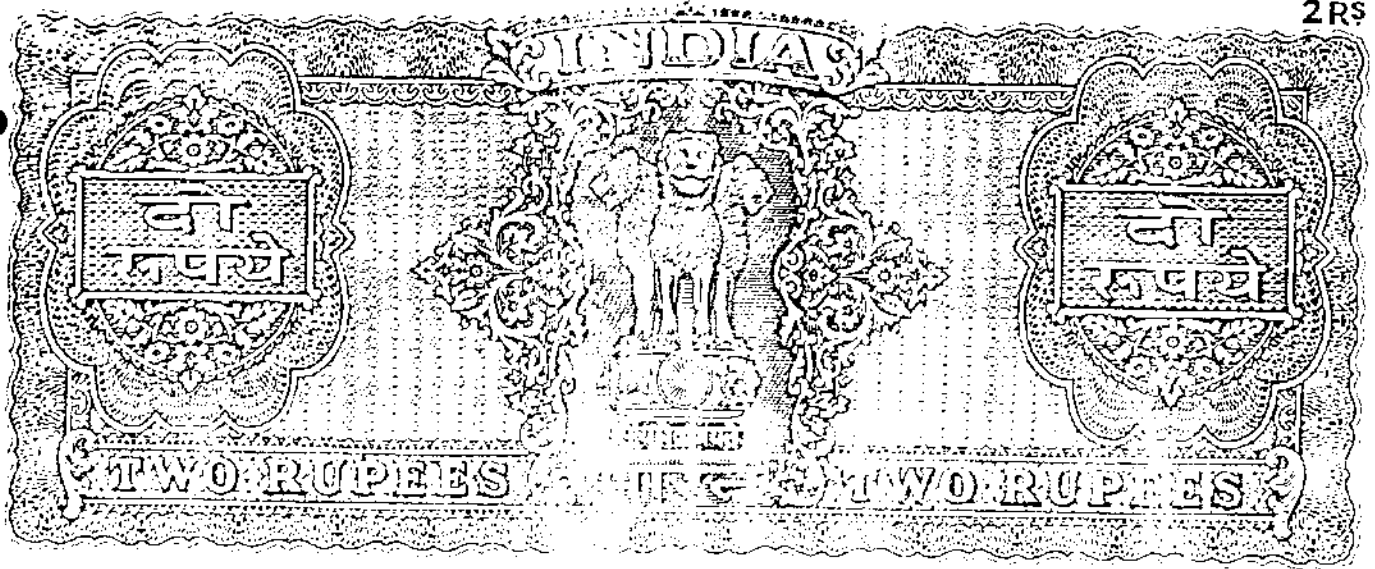
The name of the Society is 'Nayagarh Kala Parisad' established dated 01.01.2000.

The registered office of the Society is at - Rameswar Sahi, P.O./P.S./Dist - Nayagarh, Pin - 752070, Orissa with area of operation covered the whole District of Nayagarh

3. Interpretation

- a) The 'Act' means the Societies Registration Act, 1860 as amended from time to time and as applicable to the State of Orissa
- b) The 'Society' means Nayagarh Kala Parisad.
- c) The 'Office' means the registered office for the time being of the Society.
- d) The 'Seal' means the common seal of the Society.
- e) 'Governing Body' means the body is whatever named called entrusted for the time being for the management of the Society under its resolution
- f) 'Member' when used in relation to the Society means a person who has been admitted with the consent as the member of the Society according to its resolution.
- g) Advisory Council shall mean a body of individuals appointed as the friend, philosopher and guide to the Governing Body in the matter of decision making, judgement, programme planning and representative to the Govt. and Non-Govt. agencies.

4. a) The Society will have a Governing Body consisting of seven members.

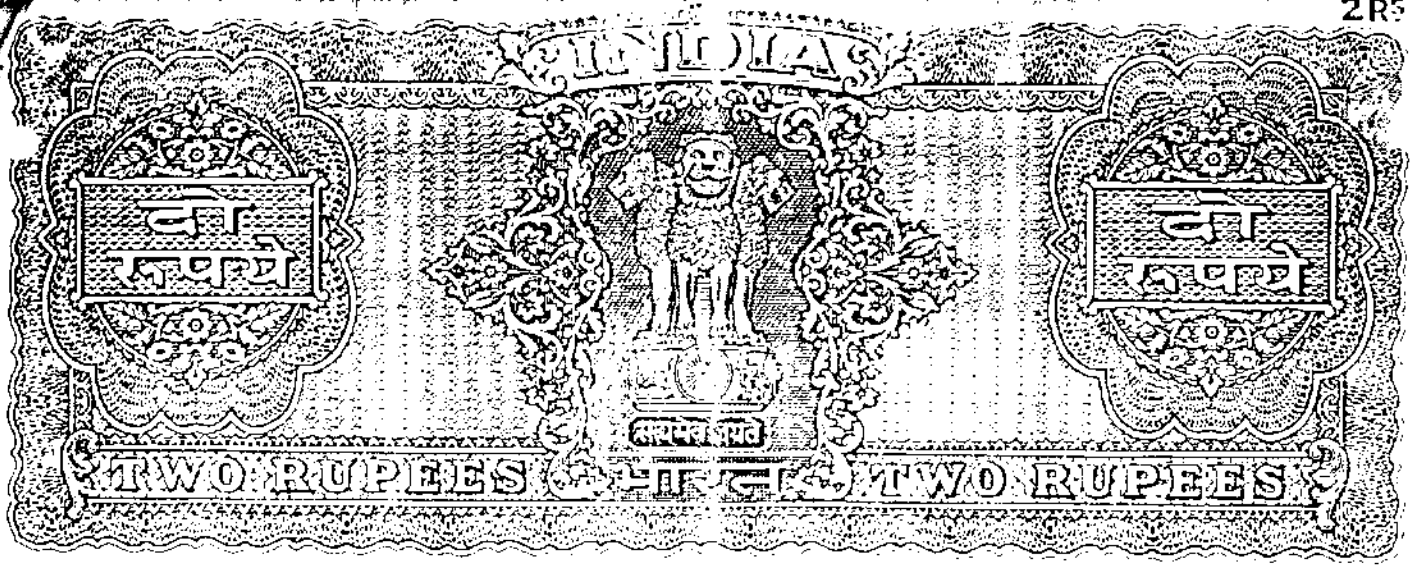
The management of the Society shall be vested in them. All business shall be transacted in the name of the Society. The Governing Body shall consist the following members at present.

4. b) i) The members of the Governing Body will be elected by the members of the Society once in five year duration.
- ii) The casual vacancies among the nominated and elected members of the Governing Body shall be filled up by the Governing Body.
- iii) The Governing Body shall meet once in every three months.
- iv) The Governing Body shall be responsible for the maintenance and management of all activities of the Society.

4. c) POWER OF THE GOVERNING BODY

- i) To get the Society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860.
- ii) For any of the objects and purposes of the Society, to employ and procure the assistance of and to suspend, discharge and dismiss any personnel or staff, useful as requires either for remuneration or gratuitously and for such terms as the Governing Body deem fit.



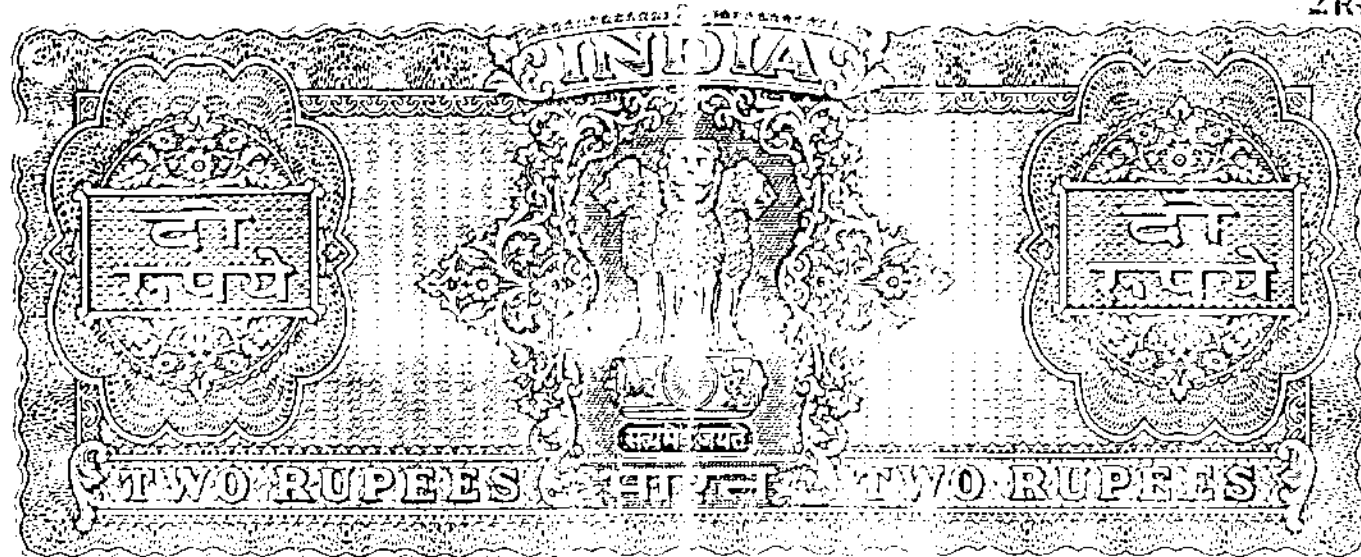

- iii) To invest and deal with the funds and money of the Society not immediately required in such shares and securities, for the investment of trust or in such other manner as Governing Body may from time to time at their absolute discretion deem fit and at the discretion from time to time to vary and transpose such investments into or others of any kind, and to lend money and property of the Society with or without security on such terms as the Governing Body may think fit.
- To build, construct and maintain houses, buildings and structures and to alter, extend, improve, repair, enlarge, modify, demolish, pull down, reconstruct or otherwise deal with the same and to provide and equip the same with all such instructions, apparatus, appliances, amenities and necessities as Governing Body deem fit.
- iv) To deposit money at any Bank or Banks, either in Savings Account or Current Account or Fixed deposits and to withdraw such money from time to time or at any time and to deposit money in Government post Offices or in Co-Operative Societies and to withdraw such money from time to time or at any time and to open and operate on such term and such manner as the Governing Body deem fit, provided that no such money will ordinarily be operated upon and except on the joint signature of either of any two of the President, Secretary and/or Treasurer.
- v) To enter into and carry out arrangements for first working or for amalgamation with any other Society or institution having objects within the objects of the Society
- vi) Generally to do all such other things as may be deemed by the Governing Body to be incidental or conclusive to the attainment of all or any of the above objects
- vii) To form committee or sub-committee for various special sections of the Society with representation, two from the members of the Governing Body, two from the other members and the advisors of the Society.

5. FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS

- i) PRESIDENT -
- a) To preside the meeting of the Governing Body and the General Body meeting
 - b) To inspect the records and the accounts of the Society.
 - c) To suggest on the affairs and activities of the Society.



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ii) VICE-PRESIDENT :-

To perform duties of the President in his absence and assist him for the same.

iii) SECRETARY :-

a) To keep a list of properties, title of deeds and other paper of the Society and will be responsible for the same.

b) To sign all documents and affix the seal of the Society to all documents required to be sealed

c) To convene the Governing Body meeting and place before the same all information and transaction of the Society

d) To manage the various affairs of the Society as and when directed by the Governing Body to sue and to be sued for and on behalf of the Society from time to time.

iv) JOINT-SECRETARY :-

To perform duties of the Secretary in his absence and assist him for the same

v) TREASURER :-

a) To open an account in any Bank in the name of the Society and to operate the same on behalf of the Society along with the Secretary

b) To collect all subscription, donation and other money payable to the Society.

c) To make payment for the various proposed items as and when suggested by the Secretary.

d) To keep proper account of all receipt and expenditure of the Society.

vi) MEMBER :-

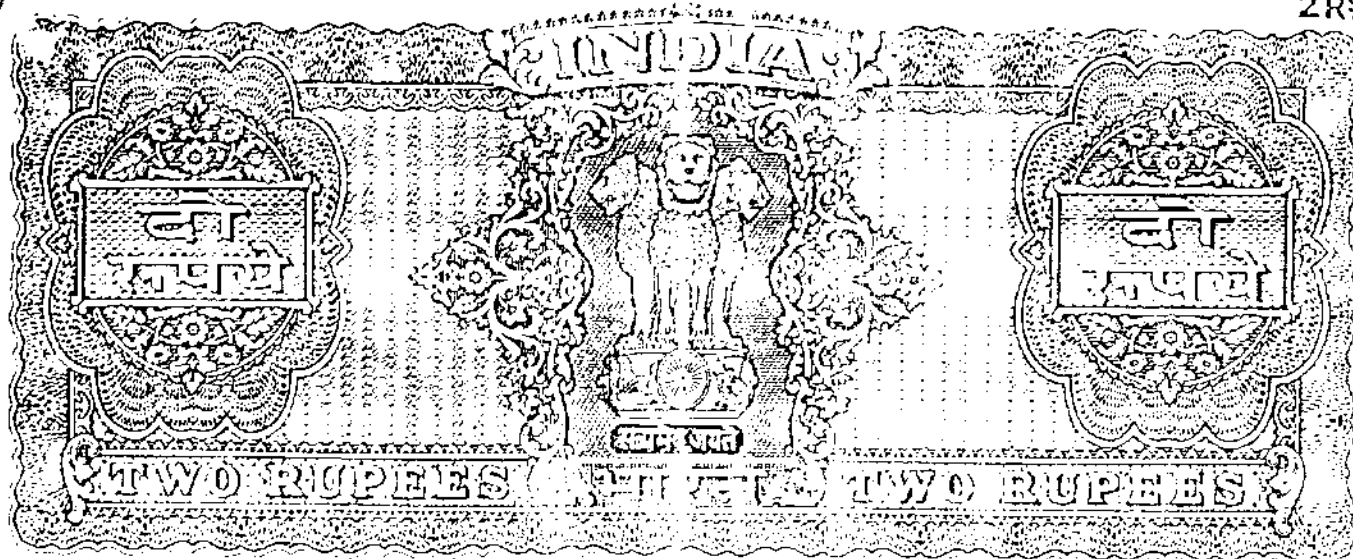
Should be a member representing the Society Governing Body.

6. MEMBERSHIP :-

i) A person to be eligible for admission to the membership should duly be selected by the General Body and pay annually Rs. 10/- with an entry fees an Rs. 2/- and he of the age of more

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He should abide by the rules and regulations of the Society as may be framed from time to time

He should not have been disqualified to become a member of the Society.

A member shall be disqualified :-

- a) If he is not a resident within the operation area of the Society.
- b) Had defaulted subscription for more than one year
- c) Has indulged in acts detrimental to the interest of the Society
- d) Is an undischarged insolvent
- e) Is a convict and has suffered imprisonment

The question of the disqualification shall be decided by the General Body meeting

PROCEDURE FOR ENROLLMENT -

A person who desires to be a member of the Society should submit an application of prescribed form with the recommendation of any two of the members of the Society, in writing, to the Secretary of the Society. The Secretary on receipt of the application will scrutinise the same, if he is satisfied that the application is in order he shall place the same before the ensuing Governing Body meeting of the Society for approval. If the application is not in order, the Secretary shall give an opportunity to the applicant to rectify the defects as may be pointed out and thereafter, if rectified, the Secretary should place the same again before the Governing Body for approval. The Secretary shall have right to call for any particulars from any applicant concerning enrollment. The applicant shall have no absolute right to get himself enrolled as a member. The Governing Body may enroll the applicant as a member or may reject the application in the interest of the Society. The Governing Body if rejects the application shall endorse the reasons therefore and shall communicate the same to the applicant.

The applicant if disqualified may prefer an appeal to the General Body of the Society whose decision shall be final and binding and shall not be called in question.

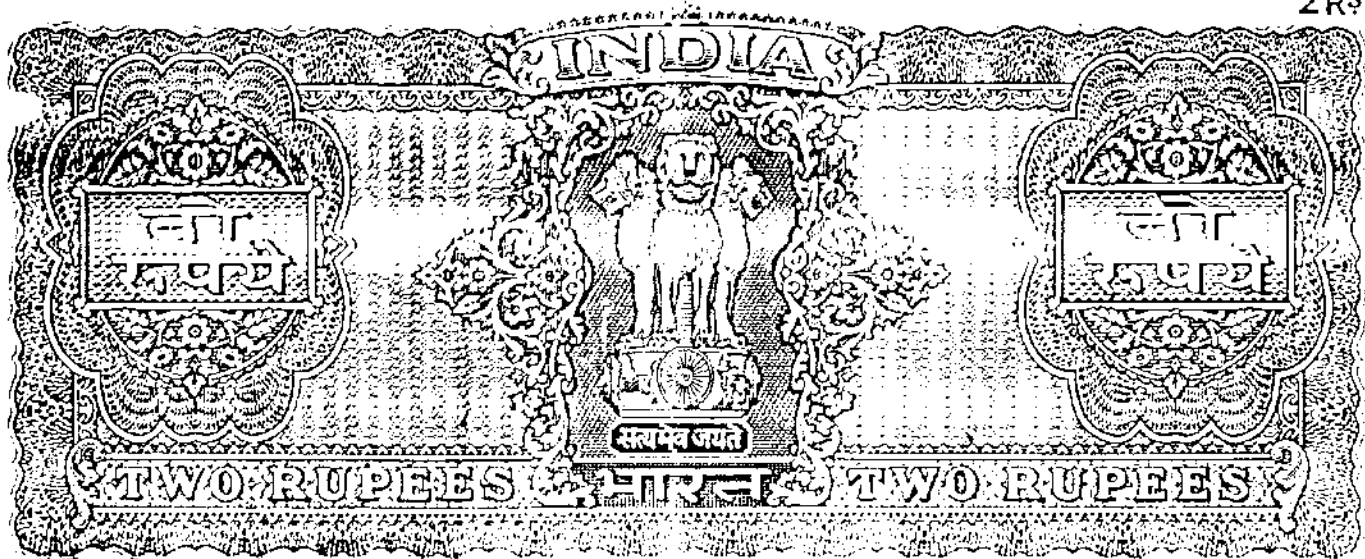

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ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING



A General Body meeting of the Society shall be held atleast once in a year at such place of such time as the Governing Body of the Society shall fix. In default of the General Body meeting being so held, a general Body meeting shall be held at the following month and may be called by a requisition signed by atleast 12 (twelve) members of the Society. The above mentioned General Body meeting shall be called as ordinary meeting. All other General Body meeting shall be called extra ordinary General meeting. The governing Body may called an extra ordinary General meeting at any time and place when the deem it necessary

ii) Procedure of General Body meeting:

14 (Fourteen) days notice specifying the place, date and time of the meeting and general nature of the business shall be given in the notice to each member. No business shall be transacted at the general body meeting unless quorum of 12 (twelve) members present and proceeding to the business except as there in otherwise provided. The General Body meeting shall be held at registered office.

iii) The Annual General Body meeting will discuss over the following, each time placed before it

- a) To receive the report of the Governing Body, the accounts of the Governing Body and its auditors report for the year ending on 31st March, next preceding the date of the meeting.
- b) To consider or decide only matters which may be brought the General Body meeting with the permission of the chairman presiding at such meeting.

10. QUORUM:-

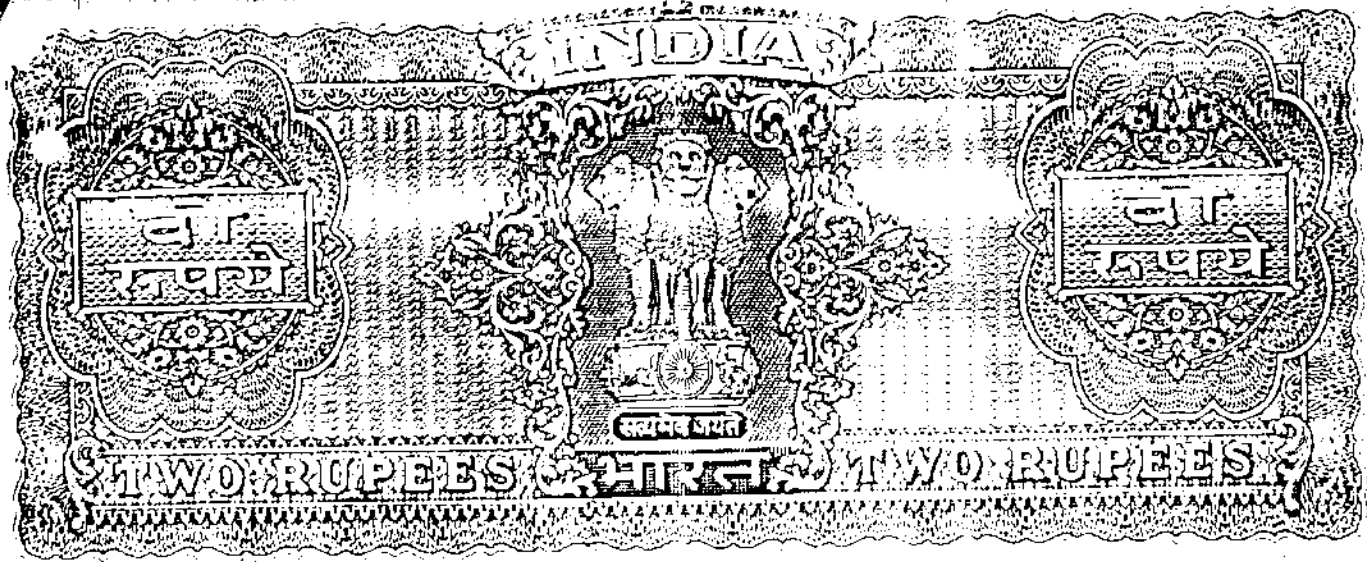
1/3rd (One third) members personally present both at the commencement and during the proceeding of the meeting shall be a quorum for a General meeting

11. VOTING:-

At all meeting of the Society or the governing body meeting, every member present shall have one vote, voting by proxy shall not be allowed

12. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:-

- i) The governing body shall be in full charge of maintaining the books of accounts and such other



ii) The cash and bank balance of the Society are to be perfectly maintained by the treasurer as to its inflows and outflows.

iii) The governing body shall lay before every annual general body meeting

A Balance Sheet as on 31st March

A statement of Receipt and Payment as on 31st March, duly certified by a Chartered Accountant.

c) An Income and Expenditure Account as on 31st March, duly certified by a Chartered Accountant.

iv) The governing body shall appoint every year a qualified Chartered Accountant to audit the account of the Society or audit by govt. auditor.



13. SEAL:-

There shall be a common seal of the Society which shall be affixed at the direction of the Governing Body. The composition of the said seal may be attained from time to time by the resolution of the governing body

14. DISSOLUTION:-

If there should be a dissolution of the Society, at the time, any property or assets, whatsoever should remain over, in the satisfaction of the debts and liabilities of the Society the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Society or among any of them, but shall be given the same to some other Society whose aim appears similar to or near as may be the objects of the dissolved Society and the said Society shall be determined by the vote of not less than 3/5 (Three fifth) of the members of the Society, present personally at a general body meeting convened for the consideration thereof, in accordance with the provisions of the Societies Registration Act of 1860 or to the Government

APPROVAL U/s 80G(5)(vi) OF THE INCOME TAX ACT, 1961

The application filed in Form No. 10G seeking approval in the above case on 30.05.2011 has been examined and I am satisfied that:

- (i) This is a fund/trust as mentioned in clause (iv) of Sub-section 2 of Sec. 80G of the I.T.Act,1961.
- (ii) The donations made to the said trust /fund /society do qualify for deduction in computing the income of a person who makes the donation i.e. in the hands of the donor.

Accordingly the approval sought for is hereby accorded u/s 80G(5)(vi) of the I.T. Act, 1961.

2. The approval shall have **with effect from 01.06.2011** subject to all other provisions of the I.T.Act, 1961 as applicable and the following conditions:

- (i) The receipts issued to the donors should bear the number and the date of this order and it should state clearly the validity of the certificate effected from.
- (ii) Regular return of income should be filed before the Assessing Officer in time under intimation to this office.
- (iii) The fund or institution shall submit the statement of income and expenditure and other financial statements for the year ended on 31.03.2011 and subsequent year(s) within the prescribed time before the prescribed authority.
- (iv) The fund / institution shall maintain the books of account regularly and also get them audited as required under Clause (b) of Sub-section(1) of Section 12A of the I.T. Act.
- (v) The fund or institution shall file the Return of Income regularly as stipulated u/s 139(i) read with section 139(4A).
- (vi) No change in the Deed of Trust / Society / Association/ Company shall be effected without the concurrence of law. In case order of the jurisdictional High Court and its intimation shall be given immediately to this office.
- (vii) The fund or institution shall maintain separate books or accounts in respect of business activity as stipulated in the provision of Clause (b) of Sub-section(5) of Section 80G. The donations received should not be used directly or indirectly for the purpose of business.
- (viii) No expenditure should be incurred which is a religious nature in any previous year in excess of five percent of its Total Income of the previous year.
- (ix) Charitable purpose does not include any purpose the whole or substantially the whole of which is of a religious nature.
- (x) No deduction under Section 80G shall be allowed in respect of any donation unless such donation is a sum of money.
- (xi) The funds or institution seeking exemption shall fulfill the conditions specified in Sub-Section (5) of Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.



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
